WRITING YOUR PERSONAL STATEMENT

Applicants need to submit a paper that explains their desire to be entered into the social work program. The personal statement will explain personal qualities and values that are considered to be essential to the profession of social work: good and effective communication skills, sense of responsibility, compassionate qualities, adaptability, and a commitment to social justice, empowering individuals and serving the oppressed. Illustrating personal qualities and professional experiences need to be articulated in your Personal Statement. This portion of the application will be approximately 5 pages in length (double spaced) and must be typed. The Personal Statement is used to evaluate your written communication skills. The Personal Statement needs to cover the following:

PART I:

Explain how volunteer, paid and, life experiences related to social work have guided your decision in selecting social work as a career path at the B. A. level. Discuss the major reasons for selecting social work as your professional path.

Explain experiences you have had in helping someone from a different background from yours and any situation related to issues (problems) of social, economic or oppressed people.

Explain how the above experiences express that your personal values are compatible with the Social Work Code of Ethics. (The Code of Ethics can be found online: www.naswdc.org/pubs/code/default.asp)

PART II:

Discuss your motivation for, expectations regarding, and commitment to the social work program at Tabor College. Discuss any factors which have assisted toward the decision to enter or continue in the field of Social Work, and any experiences which you believe will be helpful as a student in Social Work, including: 1) employment, 2) education, 3) special interests, 4) family influences, 5) volunteer service, or other.

Identify particular assets that you would bring to the program and to the profession, as well as areas in which you would most like to grow academically and professionally. Describe some successes you have achieved in education, employment and personally. Describe any barriers you have had to conquer in achieving your personal and educational goals.

Discuss your readiness to undertake study toward a professional degree and anticipated satisfaction or challenges with regard to the choice of the social work profession.

I certify that, to the best of my knowledge, all information provided on this application and supporting documents submitted are true and complete. I also certify that, in the event that an aspect of my life significantly changes any part of this application, I will inform the Social Work Program director immediately. I understand that intentional falsification, misrepresentation, or failure to supply required information in compliance with this application is sufficient cause for denial of my application or dismissal from the social work program.
