Purpose of Award:

The purpose of this award is to recognize academic performance and potential success for students majoring in Mathematics.

Requirement for Scholarship Application:

1. A resume.
2. Minimum ACT math sub-score of 28 or minimum SAT math sub-score of 625.
3. Grade Point Average
 - a. For incoming freshmen, a minimum high school GPA of 3.5.
 - b. For incoming transfer students, a minimum transfer GPA of 3.5.
4. A completed application form.
5. An on-campus interview with the Mathematics department.

Requirements of Scholarship winners:

1. Take Kansas intercollegiate mathematics exam and Putnam exam (sophomore year and beyond). Engage in practice for these competitions.
2. Act as Teacher's Aide for classes and tutor as needed.
3. Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.

Criteria for application evaluation:

1. Prior academic performance.
2. Perceived potential for success in the profession or pursuit of graduate school after graduation.
