Federal Student Aid Eligibility Requirements

- Be officially accepted to Tabor College
- Submitted to Tabor College **all** final official transcripts from previously attended institutions
- Be admitted and enrolled in an eligible program(s) of study for the purpose of obtaining a degree
- Cannot be enrolled solely in remedial coursework
- Cannot be currently enrolled in secondary school (high school)
- Submitted an official final high school transcript with graduation date or the recognized equivalent (such as a GED certificate)
- Be eligible to obtain a degree
- Have a complete and correct FAFSA on file
- If selected for verification, have a complete verification worksheet and official IRS transcript documentation or IRS confirmation the taxes were imported on the FAFSA
- Be a U.S. citizen or national, or an eligible non-citizen (verification of eligible non-citizen status may be required)
- Have a valid Social Security number (or identification number accepted by the Department of Education or Social Security Administration)
- Not have been convicted of an illegal drug-related offense *[if convicted, the student must visit FAFSA online, click “Before Beginning a FAFSA” and complete the “Drug Worksheet” (on the left) to determine if it will affect eligibility. Additional help is available by calling 800-4FED-AID (800-433-3243).]*
- Be enrolled at least half-time if applying to receive Federal Direct Student Loans
- Cannot be incarcerated
- Cannot be in default on a Federal Student Loan or owe an overpayment on a FSA grant or loan (to check the status of previous loans, go to www.nslds.ed.gov/nslds_SA/)
- Cannot have borrowed in excess of the annual or aggregate loan limits for Federal Student Aid
- If the student is a male between the ages of 18-25, he **must** register with Selective Service
- Must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- Must certify Federal Student Aid will **only** be used for educational purposes
- Demonstrate financial need for programs requiring it
- Pell Grant recipients are limited to 12 full-time semesters
