Tabor Graduate Assistant Options: Master's of Business Administration with a focus in Leadership or Sports Administration.

Length of Appointment: 2 years

Responsibilities: Responsible for working with the head coach in all aspects of developing a competitive NAIA program with some assignments for athletic administration. Candidates must affirm Tabor distinctives as a decidedly Christian college and articulate a personal relationship with Christ.
