REQUIRED to be OFF CAMPUS by 5:00 pm Saturday, December 9, 2023

RETURN to campus - residence halls reopen 12:00 pm (noon) Sunday, January 7, 2024

SPRING BREAK: MARCH 9-16, 2024

DEADLINE for overnight approval is Thursday, February 22, 2024

REQUIRED to be OFF CAMPUS by 5:00 pm Saturday, March 9, 2024

RETURN to campus - residence halls reopen 8:00 am Sunday, March 17, 2024

COMMENCEMENT: SATURDAY, MAY 4, 2024

END-OF-YEAR REQUIREMENT: ALL STUDENTS

Official check-out required with your RA and all keys returned

Must be fully moved out of residence hall by 5:00 pm Saturday, May 4

School Breaks:

- Two times per academic year, all students will be required to leave the residence halls: winter break and spring break
- Residence halls close at 5:00 pm the day after classes end
- Residence halls reopen the day before classes resume

Moving back in early to the residence halls or staying an extra night requires prior approval from Student Life and will result in a \$200 charge per night. Please see the deadlines above. Submitting a request to stay on campus does not mean your request will be approved. Students should plan to be out of residence halls at normal closure times; approvals are reserved for unique circumstances and require that the \$200 per night charge is paid upon approval.

Being in the residence halls before they open or staying an extra night without prior approval from Student Life will result in a \$300 charge per night and disciplinary action.

Please take out your room trash before leaving for a break. At the beginning of breaks, the Residential Educators or Facilities staff may enter rooms to insure lights are off, windows are closed, and appliances and fans are turned off and unplugged.
