- Tabor College has signed and returned the Department of Education (DOE) Certification and Agreement assuring that the institution has used, or intends to use, the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- 2. Tabor College has received \$8,416 from the DOE to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.
- 3. As of September 30, 2020, \$4,450 has been distributed to eligible students.
- 4. Tabor College calculates that 7 students were eligible to receive distributions.
- 5. As of September 30, 2020, 7 students had received emergency financial aid grants.
- 6. Any student may apply for a grant. Tabor College uses Expected Family Contribution (ERC) as calculated by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine which students to prioritize for grants. Tabor College uses the maximum federal Pell grant award and the remaining funds available as a guide to how much to grant to each student.
