- Administrate and communicate community expectations consistent with a Christ-centered institution and in keeping with Tabor's community covenant.
- Hold regular office hours, as assigned by the director of Residential Education
- Direct day-to-day housing operations living areas
- Cover one on-call evening per week, and share weekend on-call coverage with other Residence Life staff.
- Participate in leading orientation and arrival of new students.
- Additional ancillary duties will be assigned to each Residential Educator, such as Director of Residential Education, Student Activities Advisor, Director of Intramurals, CHUMS Director.
