- History & artifacts located in a house that was built in 1876 by Russian Mennonite immigrants, Peter and Anna Loewen

William F. Schaeffler House

- Built in the early 1900s by German immigrants and local business owners William and Ida Schaeffler.

Friesen Dutch Mill

- Located beside Adobe House, built by Jacob Friesen in 1876 to replicate a gristmill.

Kreutziger School

- A one-room schoolhouse that was built in the 1880s and located on the west side of Adobe House.
